**A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AND ADOPT A TEN YEAR CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE TIGERVILLE FIRE DISTRICT,
GREENVILLE COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA**

WHEREAS, the Tigerville Fire District (the "Tigerville Fire District") is a special taxing district within Greenville County (the "County") established to provide fire suppression and other fire protection related services to Greenville County residents residing in the Tigerville Fire District; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide the required services and to meet the fire protection needs to the residents of the Tigerville Fire District certain capital improvements (the "Capital Improvement Program") must be undertaken; and

WHEREAS, proper planning and management for the provision of fire services in the FSA requires a long range, ten-year plan to keep up with and adequately respond to the growth and demand for service in the Tigerville Fire District; and

WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Tigerville Fire District Board of Commissioners (the "Board of Commissioners") and the Tigerville Fire Chief that not only is the Capital Improvement Program necessary to adequately serve the needs of the residents of the Tigerville Fire District, but if implemented, will continue to enhance the level of those services; and

WHEREAS, the Tigerville Fire District provides a full time, professionally trained staff of firefighters, as well as volunteer firefighters, who continue to undergo rigorous additional training to be ready and skilled in fighting fires, saving lives and protecting property; and

WHEREAS, it is the further finding of the Tigerville Fire District that the implementation of the Capital Improvement Plan will result in:

- Reduced response times for calls for service;
- Reduced ISO ratings resulting in potential savings in homeowner's insurance premiums;
- Enhanced fire protection services being provided throughout the Tigerville Fire District; and
- The real potential for saving lives and increasing safety for firefighters.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tigerville Fire District Board of Commissioners hereby approves the Capital Improvement Plan for the Tigerville Fire District that is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners and the Fire Chief design and carry forward a plan to implement the Capital Improvement Program and to seek adequate financing from Greenville County to fund the program.
